

# Bokamoso Ba Rona Initiative

## West Rand Agri-Industrial Project

### Request for Qualification (RFQ): Programme Manager



The multi-stakeholder Bokamoso Ba Rona Initiative is aimed at promoting sustainable economic activity through the development of a large-scale agri-industrial and bio-energy hub, in areas on the greater West Rand District, where local economies are currently predominantly dependent on mining. Sibanye-Stillwater, the Merafong Municipality and the Far West Rand Dolomitic Water Association (FWRDWA) will make available approximately 30 000 hectares of land in the Programme Area to facilitate the development of this agri-industrial hub in the Gauteng Province.

The Founding Partners, Sibanye-Stillwater, West Rand Development Agency, GIFA and FWRDWA together with the PIC and DPME, have established a Steering Committee, whose task it will be to lead and oversee the process of developing and implementing the Programme. The Partners are seeking the services of a suitably qualified Programme Manager (through a consortium or otherwise) to develop, implement and manage the Programme.

An information session will be held at **10:00** on **12 October 2018** at Sibanye-Stillwater's Academy in Glenharvie to allow for potential respondents to obtain clarifications.
