SCOPE OF WORKS - AFFILIATE BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES

1. SUPPLY AND SERVICING OF PORTABLE TOILETS

- Service provider to be a registered company and compliant with relevant legislation (SARS, COIDA, Companies Act, etc.)
- Service Provider to be registered as a Hazardous Waste Transporter,
- Service Provider’s vehicle to be registered as a Hazardous Waste Transport Vehicle,
- Documented evidence in the form of a Service Level Agreement (SLA) between the transporter and waste handling facility,
- Documented evidence in the form of an SLA between the transporter and spill response,
- Documented evidence of experience on previous projects with contactable references,
- Employees must have:
 - Hazardous Chemical Training,
 - Professional Driving Permit (PDP),
 - A clear criminal record and pass security screening,
 - TEBA clearance / be terminated from any previous employers,
 - Pass a medical fitness examination relevant to scope of duties.
- Payment terms shall be 30 days from the invoice date.
- All Rates **must exclude Vat @15%** (If Vat registered)

2. SUPPLY OF DIESEL (50PPM)

- Rates shall be linked to Pump Price fluctuations and delivered to site.
- Please quote for the rate per liter delivered.
- Quantities shall be re-measurable and in accordance slips of fuel dispensed.
- Diesel will be subjected to random testing.
- If there are any stoppages due to Suppliers own doing, the Contractor may claim costs against the Supplier for any inefficiencies and/or cost of resources.
- Service provider to be a registered company and compliant with relevant legislation (SARS, COIDA, Companies Act, etc.)
- Documented evidence in the form of an SLA between the transporter and spill response,
- Documented evidence of experience on previous projects with contactable references,
- Employees must have:
 - Hazardous Chemical Training,
 - Professional Driving Permit (PDP),
 - A clear criminal record and pass security screening,
 - TEBA clearance / be terminated from any previous employers,
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- The Supplier shall always adhere to the Occupational Health and Safety policies and procedures. Any non-conformance may result in work stoppages for which no counter claim shall be entertained.

4. BRICKWORK (Labour Only)

- Sub Contractor to be a registered company and compliant with relevant legislation (SARS, COIDA, Companies Act, CIDB etc.
- Employees will be required to have clear criminal record and be subjected to pass security screening.
- TEBA clearance / be terminated from any previous employers,
- Pass a medical fitness examination relevant to scope of duties.
- Documented evidence of experience on previous projects with contactable references,
- Payment terms is 30 days from Invoice.
- All Rates must excludes Vat @15% (If Vat registered)
- The Sub-Contractor will be required to submit a **safety file**.
- The Sub-Contractor shall adhere to OHS policies and procedures. Any non-conformance may result in work stoppages for which no counter claim shall be entertained.
- The Sub-Contractor will be responsible for all quality assurance and quality control documentation.
- All Masonry materials, Components, Workmanship and testing shall comply to SANS 10164 "The structural use of masonry"
- Bricks laid on a full bed of mortar 10mm thick, All vertical and horizontal joints to be filled solid with mortar.
- All joints will be "Key joints"
- Vertical control joints to be provided min 9m between wall endings or returns.
- All lintels over openings to have a minimum of 230mm bearing at each end.
- Brickforce built into every 4th course and every course for 3 courses above or below openings in walls.min lap 400mm.
- Brickforce continuous at L and T joints.

- Brickwork will be fixed to columns with eco tibond brick anchors.
- 10mm softboard to be placed where the brickwork is against a column.
- If there are any stoppages due to Sub-Contractors own doing, the Contractor may claim costs against the Subcontractor for any inefficiencies and/or cost of resources.
