# Improving Sanitation for Safer School

Enhanced sanitation supports better health, improved attendance, and more dignified learning conditions for children in under-resourced areas.

In alignment with the Department of Basic Education’s national SAFE (Sanitation Appropriate for Education) initiative, the Foundation committed R3,87 million toward eliminating pit latrines and installing safe, modern sanitation facilities in schools across Limpopo, Mpumalanga, and the Eastern Cape.

This initiative delivered improved sanitation infrastructure to three schools—St. Mark’s College, St. Mark’s Primary in Limpopo, and Ngqanda Junior Secondary in the Eastern Cape. New toilet facilities were constructed, and existing systems were upgraded to ensure safer, more hygienic environments for learners.

Working in partnership with Gift of the Givers,

Breadline Africa, and the Archbishop Thabo Makgoba Development Trust, the Foundation funded the installation of EaziFlush™ toilets, Enviroloo pedestals, JoJo tanks, and rainwater harvesting systems in multiple schools. These efforts have restored dignity, reduced health risks, and improved learner attendance, particularly for young girls previously impacted by a lack of safe facilities during menstruation.
